Draft Major Plan Amendment A East lake – The Causeway Area (DPA-A)

Thank you for your letter of 27 June 2024 on behalf of the Griffith/Narrabundah Community Association urging the Committee to conduct an inquiry into DPA-A.

Following the Minister for Planning's referral of DPA-A to the Committee on 4 June 2024, the Committee held a private briefing with the Minister and officials to discuss the draft major amendment.

The Committee concluded that issues raised during consultation on the amendment either had been addressed or could be addressed in subsequent planning processes and resolved not to inquire into the draft amendment.

I notified the Assembly of this decision on behalf of the Committee on 27 June 2024. A copy of my statement to the Assembly is attached for your information.

I have forwarded a copy of your letter to the Minister for Planning, Mr Chris Steel MLA, and the Minister for Housing and Suburban Development, Ms Yvette Berry MLA. I have asked them to consider your correspondence and respond to you on the substantive points.

Statement to the Assembly under Standing Order 246A

Madam Speaker,

Pursuant to standing order 246A I wish to make a statement on behalf of the Standing Committee on Planning, Transport and City Services relating to a referred draft major amendment to the Territory Plan.
